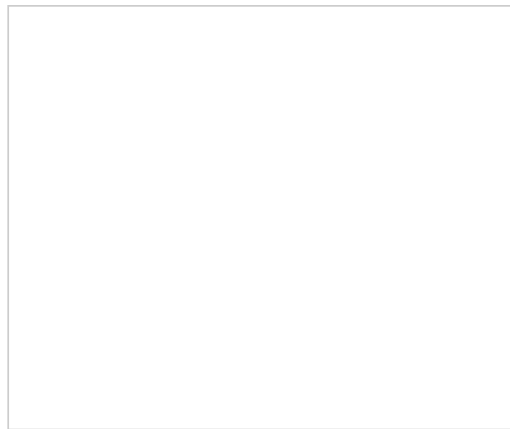
About Dr. Agnes B. Kintanar, MD
