Thankfully, I also enjoyed math and science so medical school became an obtainable reality. Electing to become an obstetrician/gynecologist and a Family Planning specialist was a natural choice for me.

What current policy issue especially motivates you to be an advocate?



Reproductive justice for immigrants. Reproductive rights are human rights and the current administration's policies towards immigrants and those seeking asylum are downright deplorable. As an immigrant myself who was once undocumented, these issues are personal.
