Appointments

We see patients by appointment only. You can schedule an appointment by calling during office hours. If you wish more that one child to be seen, please specify this when you call so enough time can be scheduled for each visit.

We understand that you can't plan when you'll get sick, so we try to keep our appointment times flexible to meet your needs. We will try to schedule a sick appointment on the same day that you call.

Your cooperation in arriving on time for your appointment helps us stay on schedule. We strive to provide each patient with the highest quality care. In the event that our schedule is delayed, please rest assured that you will also get personalized attention during your appointment.

If you must cancel your appointment for any reason, please call at least 24 hours in advance. That will allow us to offer the appointment to another patient.

First Time Patients

- Please arrive 15 minutes early from your scheduled appointment to allow for registration and paperwork.
- To save time, fill out our <u>new patient forms []</u> and bring them with you.

• Before your first appointment, call your previous doctor's office and have your records forwarded to our office.

• If your insurance company requires you to notify them when you change doctors, please call them with the name of your new primary care doctor.

What to Bring

- Your medical and drug insurance cards.
- A list of your current medications (with dosages), including any over-the-counter medications or supplements you have taken in the past six months.
- Any forms that need to be completed.

Prescription Refills

Please allow 24 hours for all prescription refills. Call your pharmacy and ask them to transmit the refill request to us electronically or fax the refill request to us at **(585) 872-0876**. The pharmacy will provide us with all the information needed to refill your prescription.

Emergencies/Hospitalizations

If you are experiencing a life-threatening emergency, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room.

We admit adult patients to Strong Memorial Hospital, an affiliate of the University of Rochester Medical Center. If you require hospitalization, we have partnered with the Strong Memorial Hospital <u>Hospitalist Service</u>. Any child that requires hospitalization is referred to <u>Golisano Children's Hospital</u>.
