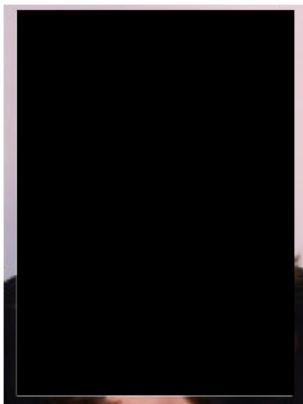


Nicole Araneta, MD
