This letter is to file a complaint for violations of the New Mexico Occupational Health and Safety Regulations by Dr Franz Theard and New Mexico Regulation 11.5.1 NMAC Section 16. Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park is engaging in dangerous practices which has left one employee dead and another one in ICU due to contraction of Covid-19. The clinic has failed to report this as required by law.

On August 7, 2020 adopted regulations to the Emergency Medical Act, this act requires employees to report positive cases of Covid-19 within 4 hours. The regulation states as follows: "Within four (4) hours of learning that an employee of tested positive for coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) each employer shall report the positive test to the bureau at the email, telephone or facsimile number of specified in Subsection B of this section." 11.5.1 NMAC Section 16 (Emphsis Added)

Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park is owned and operated by Franz Theard MD. Recently, it has been confirmed that Franz Theard was in the Intensive Care Unit for Covid-19 related problems and that Nurse Manager Gloria Martinez has passed away from Covid-19. (see email included from Mark Bracken as exhibit "A")

The New Mexico Department of Health has no enteries of any Rapid Response Team notifications and the NM OSHA Department has no record that Women's Reproductive Clinic or Franz Theard fulfilled their duty under New Mexico Regulation 11.5.1 NMAC Section 16. (see inspection of public records requests attached as exhibit "B" and "C")

Abortion is an elective procedure undertaken by women 20-34. According to Dr David Scrase, this happens to be the same age group of people with the highest infection rate. Further, the close proximity of the patient and the use of a vacuum asperation machine may lead to the aerosolization of droplets which contain the Covid-19 virus. As such, Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park could be the source of a super spreader event. All patients of Dr Theard's clinic should be notified of the infection that has killed one staff member and hospitalized another. This will enable patients to protect themselves and their families.

Due to the extreme infection at Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park, the Department of Health should immediately implement protective measures for abortion clinics, such as limiting abortions to in state residents, quarantining medical staff who travel from out of state and mandatory Covid-19 testing for woman choosing elective abortions prior to procedure. If they test positive, women undergoing abortions should be encouraged to delay their procedure until such time as their symptoms are fully resolved to schedule their abortion. This will protect patients themselves in the clinic and staff who are in direct contact with patients.

Finally, a full investigation of Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park should commence immediately. The Department of Health should ensure safe written policies and procedures are in place for preventing Covid-19 are initiated, proper hygene polices are maintained, ensuring proper use of PPE, ensuring adequate ventalation is in place and a process for notifying patients is maintained by the clinic. It is further demanded that maximum penalties be imposed by the state for failing to comply with 11.5.1 NMAC Section 16, as Dr Theard and Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park have compromised the safety of staff, patients and the general public for failing to notify the New Mexico Environment Department of this extreme public health crisis they have created at the Women's Reproductive Clinic of Sunland Park.


