In response to your request of April 16, 2021 staff from the Department of Health reviewed the closure plan for the service listed above.

[REDACTED] has decided to permanently close and sell the building at Planned Parenthood Monticello Health Center. The center was temporarily closed on March 17, 2020 due to the pandemic and a decrease in patient visits and staff availability.


There were 917 patients seen in 2020. Patients were sent a letter notifying them of the closure. The letter included a list of alternate providers which are located from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] miles from the current location. If patients wish to remain with [REDACTED] will arrange for transportation since the closest Planned Parenthood center is [REDACTED] miles away. Telehealth will also be available.

The closure plan is approved effective July 31, 2021. The Operating Certificate should be surrendered immediately after that date to the New York Metropolitan Area Regional Office.

[REDACTED] is responsible for the retention of medical records for patients of Planned Parenthood Monticello Health Center. On request from the patient, [REDACTED] will provide copies to each patient or their health care provider at a reasonable cost.
