█████ explained that she came into the station to file a report about █████ she got on June 22nd, 2016. █████ had with her a detailed timeline of what happened and when, as well as a detailed description of the █████. Both were placed in the to be scanned bin. █████ went to what she called the Western Womens Center at 6765 Orchard Lake Rd. I brought up to her that I believed it was called the Women's Center of Michigan and she stated that the facility actually has multiple names when she looked it up online.

[REDACTED] doesn't remember the drive home and was asleep for 5 hours after she got back to her mom's house. When she woke up, [REDACTED] and because of this she had to miss several days of work. [REDACTED] called her boss at the time, [REDACTED] and explained that she needed some time off. [REDACTED] remembered completely what happened about 2 days later and confided in her roommate and boyfriend at the time. Her roommate, [REDACTED], at the time were a witness to her [REDACTED]. She informed her mom of how upset she was and that she should report it to someone. [REDACTED] was not so sure about reporting the incident and that's why she waited.

On August 18th 2016 I, Detective Koziarski, received and reviewed the case. I spoke with the RP, [REDACTED] and had her come into the police department on August 19th. I pulled previous reports with Dr. Kalo [REDACTED]



Dr. Kalo did a breast exam on [REDACTED]. Heather did not have a specific recollection of a breast exam being done, but states that Dr. Kalo does perform breast exams. Heather described how Dr. Kalo would do a breast exam and it was not at all how [REDACTED] described it. I asked Heather if she had ever observed Dr. Kalo do a breast exam over the patient's clothing and Heather appeared shocked by this question and stated no, of course not. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Again Heather looked at me strangely like she couldn't believe I was asking her something so ridiculous and said no.

I then spoke with Heba Maryoush who informed me that she did not specifically remember this patient. Heba also stated that Dr. Kalo is never alone with patients and that Dr. Kalo is very specific about that. Heba stated that Dr. Kalo does do breast exams and described the exam the same way that Heather did.

I then spoke to Dr. Kalo and asked him about taking a polygraph. Dr. Kalo seemed annoyed by this request, stating that he has gone through this before and had to pay \$25,000 in attorney fees and doesn't want to do that again. Dr. Kalo again stated that was why he has the rule in his office about never being alone with a patient. Dr. Kalo stated that he would not take a polygraph without talking to an attorney and being that Heather and Heba were in the room with him the whole time, he didn't feel it necessary at this point to hire an attorney.

On October 18th 2016, I left a voicemail for [REDACTED] informing her that at this time, due to no evidence and several witnesses saying that Dr. Kalo was never alone in the room, that the case would be closed. I informed [REDACTED] to file a report with LARA regarding the [REDACTED] complaints of the procedure. On November 21st I left a second voicemail for [REDACTED], and again, never receiving a call back. [REDACTED]
