# Online Registration New Hampshire Prescription Drug Monitoring Program

The New Hampshire Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) grants system access accounts to prescribers, dispensers and approved delegates so that they may look up, and view, controlled substance dispensing information on specific patients.

### Prescribers, Dispensers (and Delegates) can perform the following steps to request an account:

- To request a new account in PMP AWARXE, navigate to <a href="https://newhampshire.pmpaware.net/login">https://newhampshire.pmpaware.net/login</a>
- 2. Once at the login screen, the user must click the "Create an Account" option to begin the process.
- The first screen displayed requires the user to enter their current, valid email address and select a password. The
  password

must be entered a second time for validation. a. The password must contain at least 8 characters, including 1 capital letter and 1 special character (such as !,@,#,\$)

- 4. After the email and desired password have been entered, the user must click the "Save and Continue" button.
- 5. The second step is the role selection screen. The user can expand the role categories to select the primary role that fits their profession and can also identify up to two sub roles (e.g. Family Medicine). After the role(s) have been selected, the user must click the "Save and Continue" button.
- 6. An Account Registration: User Demographics page will be displayed. Complete ALL red asterisk fields (i.e. DEA# (please enter all active NH DEA#'s including a waivered DEA #), license #, license type, and healthcare specialty). Complete the "Personal and Employer Information" sections of the demographics page, the user must click the "Continue" button.
- A Review Profile Details page will be displayed, review your information if all information is correct the
  user must click on the "Submit & Continue" button.
- Once you have submitted your registration, you will be notified of your account status "Pending" or "Not Complete – Additional Documents Needed" (Additional validation documents are not required, as is indicated by the "None Required" message in the "Validation Documents Required" column) and to verify your email address.
- 9. Once it is determined that you have met all account requirements and your account has been approved you will receive an email



If information is incomplete or missing, a message is displayed indicating which fields must be corrected before your account request form can be submitted.

If all information has been properly supplied, a completed account request form is displayed, along with a prompt to print the form. Print the form if desired.

You will be required to change the temporary password immediately when you first attempt to access the system.



### KEY TO TRANSCRIPT

Prior to September 1967, the work of students was evaluated on the basis of 100 percent. The lowest passing grade was 75 percent except in the case of minor subjects. In the first and second years, the passing grade for each minor subject was 75 percent. In the third year, a grade of 60 percent was accepted for individual minor subjects, but the average for a group of minor subjects must have been 75 percent.

September 1967-August 1969, the work of students was evaluated on the basis of A, B, C, and F. The lowest passing trade was C.

In September of 1969, the College adopted a pass/fail method of student evaluation:

P or Pass = satisfactory completion of all course work

F or Fail = less than satisfactory performance

Fail/Pass = less than satisfactory performance in initial endeavor, course repeated and makeup work evaluated as satisfactory.

Beginning with the class entering in September 1981 (Class of 1985 and those following), student performance has been graded in courses and clinical rotations taught or supervised by the faculty of the University of Vermont College of Medicine on the basis of honors, pass, or fail. However, the following courses are/were graded on a pass/fail basis without any honors grade option:

Basic Clerkship
Case Studies in Health and Illness
Clinical Electives during the Basic
Science Core
Doctoring Skills

Doctoring in Vermont Human Behavior Medical Sexuality Physician and Society Physician in Society

Courses in the Advanced Basic Science Core have been graded on a pass/fail basis beginning with the Class of 1994.

Courses and clinical rotations not supervised by the University of Vermont College of Medicine faculty are recorded as pass or fail on our transcript, though the faculty evaluator at another institution may have awarded a different grade based on the grading system in effect at the other institution.

Course work is completed only when grades appear. All courses without grades have not yet been completed.




